Overview: The Group assessed the wines the wines very closely in the range 90-92 pints with one out layer at 88 points for the Carmenere. Given the high-quality f the wines and their similarities in terms of fruit, tannins and acidity the most difficult part was to determine the predominant grape varieties in each one. The group unanimously choose the Bramare Cabernet as the preferred one.

Best Rated Wine: The Montes Alpha Red and the Bramare Malbec wines obtained 92 points each. The group unanimously voted the Malbes as their prefrred one.

Best Value for Money: All wines have a similar price quality ratio.
