Overview: Six participants out of seven returned the tasting sheets, one did not score the wines but merely indicated the order of preference and only four participants rated the Chardonnay. The range of scores was between 88 and 91 points resulting in the wines judged from very good to excellent. A show of hands indicated that the preferred wine was the 2013 Garage, followed by the 2013 Julio Julián (however, not available in the DC area market). The Imaginador turned out to be a light red easy to drink judged as "Very Good" by most participants while the Garage turned out to be the best of the lot. The decision on the bet buy is somewhat difficult between the Garage, excellent at \$37 or the Imaginador, very good at \$20. The narrow range of scores would incline the decision in favor of the latter.
